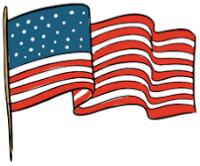
In June the girls will be working on their scrapbook to be presented at the National Convention in July.

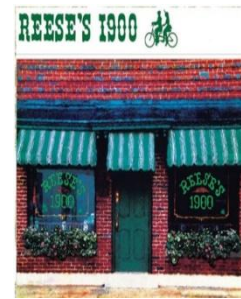
